

















Item 2	Proposal for Introduction of B.Sc. Cyber Security and Upgradation of B.Sc. AI to B.Sc. AI & ML
Discussion	<p>The Academic Council discussed the growing demand for skilled professionals in the fields of Cyber Security, Artificial Intelligence, and Machine Learning. The members appreciated the proposal for introducing B.Sc. Cyber Security to provide students with practical and industry-relevant knowledge in information and network security.</p> <p>The Council also discussed the upgradation of B.Sc. AI to B.Sc. AI & ML to align the program with current technological advancements and industry requirements. The revised program is expected to enhance students' employability, technical skills, and research opportunities in emerging technologies.</p>
Resolution	Resolved to approve the introduction of the B.Sc. Cyber Security program and the upgradation of B.Sc. AI to B.Sc. AI & ML from the Academic Year 2025–26, subject to approval from the concerned authorities.

Item 3	Ratifying the syllabus approved for I, II and IV Semester in BoS meetings
